

Working Wheels Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to <https://workingwheelswnc.org/> and W4H DBA Working Wheels and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to W4H DBA Working Wheels include <https://workingwheelswnc.org/> and Working Wheels. The Working Wheels website is a Nonprofit Organization site. By using the Working Wheels website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

In order to better provide you with products and services offered on our Site, Working Wheels may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- First and Last Name
- Mailing Address
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number
- Vehicle Information

If you purchase Working Wheels's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction.

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services available on the Site. Use of your Personal Information

Sharing Information with Third Parties

Working Wheels does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Working Wheels, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.
